Registration is on a first come, first served basis. We will have a waiting list for full sessions and will fill the classes from the earliest name on the list. Sessions that do not meet minimum enrollment may be cancelled. Registration and a non-refundable \$100 per child, per week, deposit is required to hold a space. The balance is due prior to the first class. No refund of tuition (or portion thereof) will be granted for absences. No make-up sessions will be offered for missed days.

Kids Summer Craft Camp
At Laurel Street Arts



Every summer, Laurel Street Arts offers a summer craft camp for kids entering grades 2 through 8. Campers work on two to four projects per day, playing with crafts both fired and non-fired. The crafts can be anything from pottery painting to mosaics, soap making to glass painting, weaving to glass fusing. They may vary from week to week and may be adapted for the kids in each session.

Laurel Street Arts offers 3 summer camp sessions. Session A is for families with siblings who want to craft together. Crafts are designed to challenge older kids yet not frustrate younger kids. Session B is for younger artists to focus on crafts more suitable for their age. Session C crafts allow older kids to learn a little more about each craft and may span multiple days. All sessions are 4 hours per day (9:30–1:30) with a break for lunch (not provided).

Session A: Going into Grades 2–7
\$350 per week (plus tax)



Session B: Going into Grades 2–5
\$350 per week (plus tax)



Session C: Going into Grades 6–8
\$375 per week (plus tax)



Note: While the curriculum may be repeated from week to week, the individual projects may change somewhat so repeat artists can have a varied experience. Artists may not, however, attend more than 2 weeks per summer.
